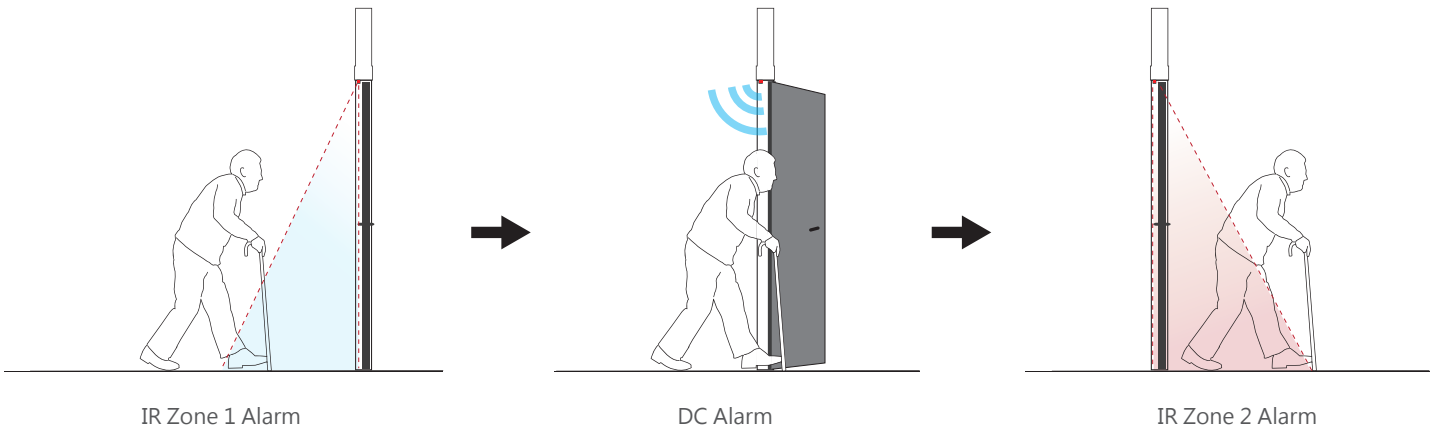
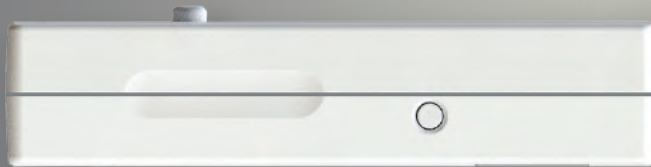
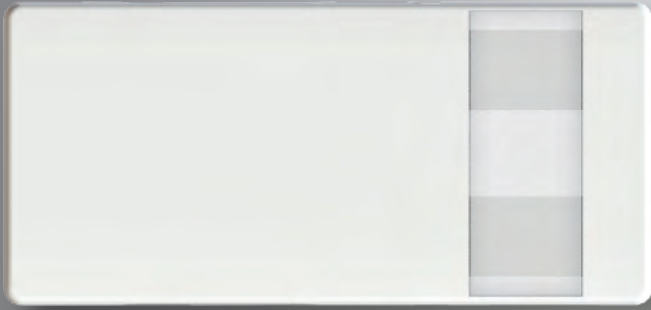


WADC-1 Wandering Prevention Door Contact

An Ideal Choice to Guard the Entrances and Exits

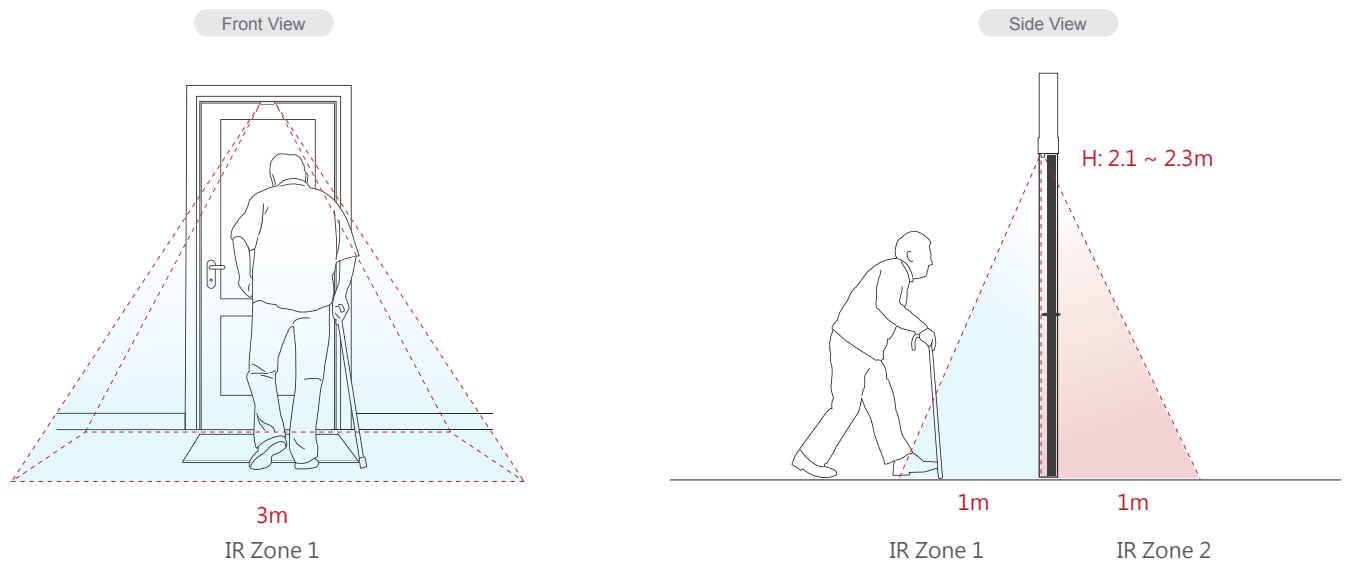
